Use these PDFs as a structured research/document library

The campaign website should separate short voter-facing policy pages from longer public-interest documents. The homepage should stay simple and local. The document library can hold deeper essays, evidence notes, draft briefs, FOI records, and public-interest allegations framed carefully.

Recommended public disclaimer block

This document library contains campaign commentary, public-interest research, policy proposals, draft briefs, and records requests. Allegations should be read as claims requiring verification unless supported by linked records. Nothing here is legal advice or a finding of misconduct.

Website structure

- Homepage: lead with “Great Scott for Mayor,” “Hastings Recovery Plan,” and “Basic dignity. Safer streets. Lower costs. Smarter government.”
- Platform: six pillars only; keep it readable for voters.
- Policy Library: use cards with evidence badges.

- Research and Documents: put long briefs, FOI records, and sensitive allegations here.
- The Bigger Vision: put Trump, Great State of Canada, and national strategy here, not in the homepage hero.
- Footer: include authorization and campaign-finance compliance language.

Evidence badge system

- Published source: public record or verified citation available.
- FOI pending: request made or planned, records not yet released.
- Campaign estimate: useful for debate but must be verified before official use.
- Legal review required: proposal may need municipal, provincial, federal, or elections-law review.
- Pilot concept: prototype or policy idea, not official city program yet.
